Furthermore very good results were achieved for the **Half armour, German, about 1550/1560** (sold for CHF 25.960, incl. buyer's premium), the **Matchloch gun, Japanese, probably partly 17th/19th century** (sold for CHF 16.520, incl. buyer's premium) and the **Barrel crossbow, Slurbow, German, around 1580** (sold for CHF 55.680, incl. buyer's premium).
